Storage

- WGP Soluble is shipped at room temperature. Upon receipt, store at room temperature (15-25°C).
- Upon resuspension, WGP Soluble is stable at least 1 month at 4°C.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Whole glucan particles (WGP) are β -glucans notable for their ability to modulate the immune response. InvivoGen provides WGP in two forms, WGP Dispersible (WGP® Dispersible), and WGP Soluble (WGP® Soluble).

WGP Soluble is a soluble Saccharomyces cerevisiae β -glucan preparation that inhibits Dectin-1b-dependent responses. It is a control for WGP Dispersible, a Dectin-1-agonist. WGP Soluble binds Dectin-1b without activating this receptor. Furthermore, it significantly blocks the binding of WGP Dispersible to macrophages and its immunostimulatory effect 1. Similarly to the particulate WGP Dispersible, WGP Soluble activates Dectin-1a, but no TLR receptors 2.

BACKGROUND

 $\beta\textsc{-Glucans}$ are carbohydrates consisting of a backbone of glucose residues. These polysaccharides are major cell wall structural components in fungi, including the yeasts <code>Saccharomyces cerevisiae</code> and <code>Candida albicans</code>. They are also found in plants and some bacteria. They are not synthesized by animals and thus are recognized by the innate immune system as pathogen-associated molecular patterns (PAMPs). This recognition is mediated by pattern recognition receptors (PRRs) and, among them, <code>Dectin-1</code> has emerged as the primary receptor².

METHODS

Preparation of WGP Soluble suspension (1 mg/ml)

- Weigh 10 mg of WGP Soluble.
- Add 10 ml of endotoxin-free water and vortex to homogenize.
- Serial dilutions can be prepared using the appropriate amount of water.

Dectin-1 inhibition using WGP Soluble

WGP Soluble can be used to inhibit Dectin-1 in murine macrophages RAW-Blue $^{\text{TM}}$ cells. These cells endogenously express Dectin-1. Additionally, they feature an NF- κ B-inducible SEAP (secreted embryonic alkaline phosphatase) reporter gene.

InvivoGen also offers HEK-Blue™ Dectin-1 cells to study the response of the (human and/or murine) Dectin-1a and -1b signaling pathway. For more information visit: www.invivogen.com/hek-blue-clr.

- 1. Add 1 1000 ng/ml WGP Soluble to RAW-Blue™ cells or HEK-Blue™ Dectin-1 cells (5 x 10⁵ cells/ml).
- 2. Incubate cells and WGP Soluble for 1 h at 37°C, 5% CO2.
- 3. Stimulate cells with a dectin-1 ligand, such as Zymosan (10-100 mg/ml) or 10-100 mg/ml WGP Dispersible for 6-24 hat 37°C, 5% CO2.
- 4. Collect 20 µl of supernatant and add to a well of a 96-well plate containing 180 µl of QUANTI-Blue™ Solution.
- 5. Incubate the plate at 37°C for 1-3 h.
- 6. Determine SEAP levels using a spectrophotometer at 620-655 nm.
